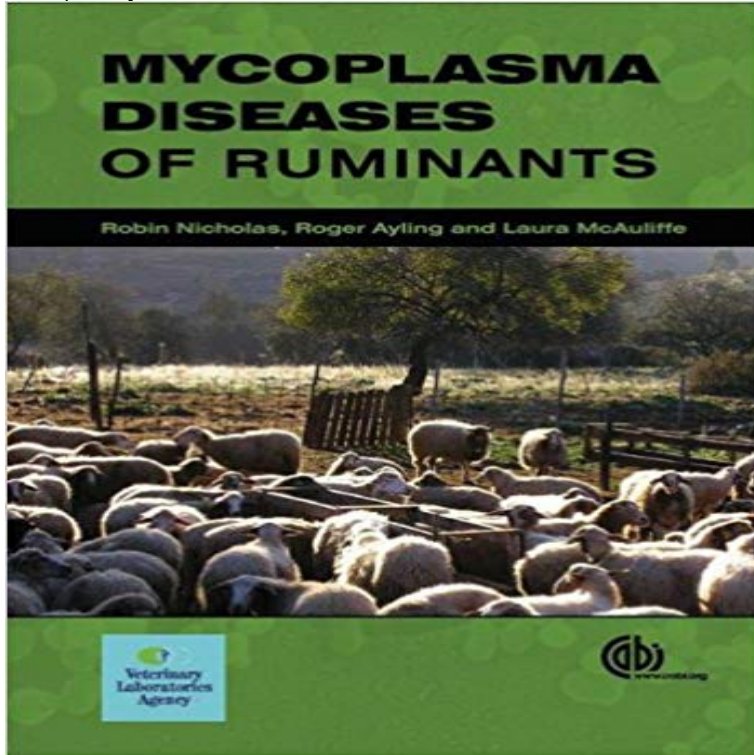


Mycoplasma Diseases of Ruminants: Disease, Diagnosis and Control
